If the lowest proposal received is over that amount, then Management will solicit additional bids to present in August. The Motion was seconded by Mr. Wiehe and carried unanimously.

### **Roof Survey**

The approach for replacing roofs as they near the end of their useful life was discussed. Management was tasked with obtaining a proposal from a roofing engineering consultant on aggregating costs with one or two other CV communities.

Tree Trimming – Ms. Craig inquired about the timing to address tree limbs which are encroaching window screens and/or roofs. Management referenced the annual pruning schedule and stated that this work would be addressed in September and October.
